- Food:
 - fruit is dual purpose when unripe it can be harvested and brined as an olive; when ripe it is eaten as a cherry.
 - * seeds can be roasted as a coffee substitute
- Wood:
 - ★ One of the densest woods will sink in water, prized for tool handles
- · Cultivation:
 - * needs a cross pollinator
 - ⋆ can be used for hedge rows
 - * very ornamental provides early food for pollinators
 - ⋆ flowers are frost proof
