# Fuzzy Kiwi

(*Actinidia deliciosa*)

## Features:

- Food: Good size fuzzy fruit; ripens in October and can store through January
- Growth Habit: Requires a sturdy trellis to support heavy brittle branches; vines can grow 7'-10' once established. Pruning required for continued fruit production.
- Pollination: 1 male can pollinate up to 8 females; Eco-sense has found that Hardy Kiwi (*A. arguta*) males pollinate well especially for early flowering females.
- Saanichton 12 is slightly more cold hardy
