L. caerulea emphyllocalyx and kamtschatica Blue Hokkaido - upright 4-5 ft Blue Velvet – spreading 4 ft tall x 5' wide Blue Mist – 2-3 ft x 3-4 ft wide Blue Pacific – 2-3 ft tall & wide Blue Pagoda - 2-3ft tall & wide



Features:

- Food blue berries in late spring; flavour of haskap has been described as somewhere between a blueberry, a Saskatoon berry and a raspberry.
- Horticultural uses a early leafing shrub that handles part shade to full sun. The more sun, the more berries, but the earlier the leaf drop (September)
