Hosta (*Hosta sp.*) H. seiboldii H. montana



Features:

• Food:

The shoots, leaf petiole, whole leaf and flowers are edible raw. Best harvested when young. Can harvest by cutting down and allowing new shoots to come again. Hosta young leaves are called Urui, often steamed. Hosta flower stems taste like asparagus, and are snapped off in the same way

 Ground cover: Shield the sun from the base of fruit trees making a good ground cover.
