- Food: - Fruit are sweet and eaten fresh or dried; EASY to process. Leaves when young used in salads
- Highly drought tolerant.
- Chickens: - prime forage and overstory protection
- Do not plant over sidewalks or cars as most varieties have fruit that stains
- Produce over a period of several months
