- Leikora fresh eating very large berries (late, Oct.)
- Hergo Juice berry (mid season, Aug.)
- Orange Energy Juice berry high yields, few thorns, (mid season, Sept.)

Smaller at 6-8ft, all early season. (P1)

- Titan exception grows to 10 ft, very large flavourful and aromatic fruit
- Russian Orange Attractive with dark orange fruit and slender long foliage High ornamental value
- Star of Altai sweetest berries; suited for dry conditions
- Botanica Very large bright orange flavourful berries, (mid season, August)
- Sirola sweet and easily picked. (early, July)
