- ★ Indian Lake 3'T x 3'W, bright red sweet berries through winter; zone 6-9; also called Pernettya mucronata
- ★ Pink Snowdrop 3'T x 3'W, white to light pink fruit, has berries through winter; zone 7-9; also called Pernettya mucronata
- * Gaultheria procumbens "Creeping Wintergreen" or "Tea Berry"; 8" tall X 2' W, red berries -sweetest with strongest wintergreen taste; leaves used in tea.
